### Presentation Type:

There are two presentation types; Oral presentation and monitor presentation.

The oral presentation is a general presentation with 7-minute talk and 3-minute discussion.

The monitor presentation is a presentation using an electric poster. The presenter stands beside the monitor on which his/her electric poster (CyPos) appears and discusses the research with interested attendees in the monitor presentation session. The monitor presentation session lasts 30 minutes.

All presenters must submit an electronic poster (CyPos) written in English by the due date.

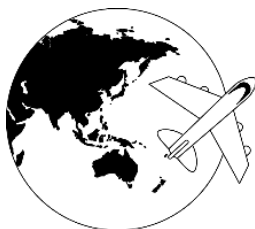
## Application for International Scholarship

Dear Participants,

The 76th Annual Meeting of the Japanese Society of Radiological Technology will be offering the following scholarship to participants who will be presenting at the 76th JSRT Annual Meeting to be held in April 9 – 12, 2020, in *Yokohama*, Japan. This International Scholarship will be offered to international students, young technologists, and researchers whose abstracts have been accepted for presentation.



The Scholarship Awardees will receive:

- A travel grant **up to 100,000 JPN** reimbursement to retroactively be used toward **airfare and accommodation costs** (will be awarded after the conference)
- Free conference registration

### Eligibility

1. Non-Japanese residents or international students attending school in Japan
2. The applicant must be the first author of an accepted abstract for oral presentation.
3. The applicant must be under age of 40 years old at the time of application.
4. The submitted abstract must be approved by the IRB if the abstract includes any of personal information such as image data, patients' diagnoses, treatment plan, and also rating scores of human observers, etc.

\* Previous JSRT scholarship recipients are not eligible.
