All presentation should be oral presentation in English using PowerPoint (Oral presentation only).

Please submit your abstract within **200 words** for proceedings of publication. The abstract should have the **Purpose** of your study, **Materials and Methods**, **Results**, and principal **Conclusion** with an emphasis on the new aspects of your study. An oral presentation is 10 minutes in length but your actual speech is 7 minutes and the rest of time should be for a question and answer session.
